Drill Tower Rules

General Drill Tower Rules

- 1. Absolutely no smoking in, on, or around tower and within 100ft of LP tanks.
- 2. There will be absolutely no alcoholic beverages or controlled substances not prescribed by a physician allowed on the premises. Use of tobacco products is allowed only in designated areas.
- 3. No participant shall consume alcoholic beverages or controlled substances not prescribed by a physician during a program, including the lunch break. In addition, no participant shall exhibit evidence of alcohol or controlled substance consumption which has occurred during non-program hours.
- 4. The directions of the program instructors shall be followed at all times, under all circumstances. The Burn Facilitator, Officer in Charge, or Safety Officer conducting the training will have maximum authority over the tower at all times. This is non-negotiable and there will be no debate as to the validity of instruction. Should conflict arise, this decision shall be carried out and complaints registered with the RPSTC manager and appropriate staff at another time.
- 5. Regional Public Safety Training Center accepts no responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged items.
- 6. All garbage will be picked up at the conclusion of the training session and placed into the designated receptacles on site.
- 7. No tear gas or pepper gas will be used in the Drill Tower.
- 8. No simunitions training of any kind may be used in the designated burn rooms.
- 9. All drills conducted within the Drill Tower shall follow a planned format.
- 10. No training will take place without notification to RPSTC staff.
- 11. If death or serious injury occurs, the RPSTC staff will be notified immediately.
- 12. All damage to the Drill Tower and associated equipment will be reported to RPSTC staff immediately.
- 13. All areas will be returned to the condition in which they were found.
- 14. No personnel will attempt any drill they have not been properly trained for.

Drill Tower Rules

Specific Fire Trainer Rules

- 1. All personnel on the burn floor must be wearing proper PPE when live fire training is in session.
- 2. All personnel actively taking part in live fire training must be trained in basic firefighting techniques and safety principles.
- 3. Any organization utilizing the <u>Fire Trainer</u> must have an authorized Burn Facilitator/Operator present, prior to any live fire training taking place.
- 4. No flammable liquids or combustible liquids are allowed in the drill tower.
- 5. **WATER** is the **ONLY** extinguishing agent to be used in any of the Fire Trainer mockups.
- 6. Proper communication will be established prior to any live fire training taking place.
- 7. Ensure everyone involved in live fire training is aware of where the Manual Emergency-Stop Pushbutton(s) are located and how to operate them.
- 8. If, for any reason, the Fire Trainer is not working properly, discontinue use immediately and contact RPSTC staff.
- 9. 2" diameter or smaller are the only acceptable hose lines for use in the interior of the drill tower.

Failure to comply with rules set forth could result in the loss of the privilege to train at the RPSTC.
